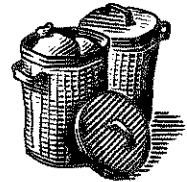


# IMPORTANT TRASH/RECYCLING NEWS

**Starting July 1, 2009 the Town will begin to enforce the Massachusetts DEP Waste Ban Regulation #310CMR 19-017. The Town's goal is to decrease trash and increase recycling. This will save money and give us a cleaner environment.**



1. Limit 5 bags/barrels of trash per dwelling
2. Trash barrel must be 35 gallon (or less) with handles; (no 60/80 gallon totters accepted for trash)
3. There is a 50 pound limit per container
4. No metal allowed in the trash; Metal may be brought to the Transfer Station on East Coast Rd. (free); and the Town will provide one FREE curbside pick up per year.
5. No construction or demolition material curbside
6. No recyclables in the trash - if the trash vendor (JRM) sees recyclables in your trash, they will **NOT** pick up your items
7. A \$10 sticker is needed for bulky items, i.e. furniture, stove, lawn mower, hot water heater, etc.
8. Two \$10 stickers are needed for Freon appliances (refrigerators, etc.), TV's and computers
9. **There is no limit on recycling.**
10. Recycling includes: glass, aluminum cans, paper, newspaper, magazines, paperboard, plastic #1-7
11. Cardboard must be cut and flattened to 3' X 3'. Large pieces must be bundled with tape or string; smaller pieces may be placed in a paper bag
12. Yard waste - watch for special pickup dates
13. Recycling may be put in any container with a "recycle" sticker that you can pick up at the Business Division or the Town Hall; if you want additional curbside "Town of Danvers" bins, you may obtain one at the Transfer Station for \$5.00 with a check made out to the Town
